28°-50° Wine Workshop & Kitchen, South Kensington

It's heartening to see a buzzy, friendly new opening on South Ken's sometimes-sterile Draycott Avenue. 28°-50° is the stuff of purest last-of-the-summer-wine fantasy: fresh, unobtrusive interiors; heavenly staff; tasty bites and a knockout wine selection. Come here to sip icy Saint-Aubin and watch the well-heeled world go by, or settle in for three courses including supremely fresh calamari with smoky chorizo followed by steak or barley risotto with crispy shallots. The wine list is refreshingly simple, comprising 15 white and 15 red varieties by the glass, carafe and bottle—and they only go for those they like, that are drinking well, and that offer good value. A punchier option comes in the form of the "Collectors' List" of fine wines from the personal cellars of private collectors, some of which are rarely seen elsewhere. A special, unstuffy new spot to head for. 28°-50°
