Skier and Snowboarders are a dedicated bunch and those of you who have been lucky enough to already hit the slopes (including Petra who has recently returned from Grindelwald in Switzerland) will testify to the excellent conditions. The ski season is well underway and with France having finally lifted its travel restrictions, now is the time to get your ski fix. We still have availability for half term and the Easter holidays. Covid-19 and Brexit have turned traditional chalet holidays upside down; Ski France has come up with a new concept, Contactless Catered Chalets. The company now offers more than 50 contactless-catered chalets across the French Alps situated in many well-known resorts such as Val d'Isère, Tignes, Méribel, Courchevel, and La Plagne. Guests arrive to find local produce and various ingredients for breakfast, afternoon tea / snack, a three-course dinner and drinks each day. Located in the idyllic Méribel Mussillon Hamlet, in the popular resort of Méribel, Chalet Brioché features four bedrooms (sleeping up to eight guests) each with an en-suite bathroom. The chalet also has a warming log fireplace, terrace with outdoor hot tub and sauna, and a large flat-screen television. Jump on the bus, which stops 100 metres from the chalet, and be whisked to the slopes ready for a day on the snowy mountains. A week's stay, from 5 February 2022, costs from £11199 total (was £13999 total – saving £2800 total) for eight people sharing the chalet on a contactless catered basis. From luxurious ski holidays in the Swiss Alps to snowboarding breaks in Italy and other lavish chalet holidays in France, we have loads more suggestions.
