Chalet Arolla, Méribel 1650 *Sleeps 10

Steam room, Outdoor jacuzzi



The recently renovated alpine property marries the traditional and the modern and comprises five ensuite bedrooms, a spacious open plan living, dining and bar area with breath-taking views, an indoor steam room and superb outdoor jacuzzi, as well as a cosy TV snug where loved ones can hunker down after an active day on the piste. A seven-night stay at Chalet Arolla, Meribel starts from €19,250 on a catered basis.

Chalet Lapin Blanc, Méribel Chaudanne *Sleeps 14 + 1

Ski-in Ski-out, Outdoor hot tub, Envable location



A mere stone's throw from the resort's main lift centre and ski school meeting points, the striking Lapin Blanc is beautifully furnished throughout with local wood and stone and peppered with British and French aesthetic. Key features include seven large ensuite rooms, an enormous sitting and dining room with central log fire, mezzanine study area, cinema room with bar, sauna and an outdoor hot tub on a secluded private south-facing balcony. A seven-night stay at Chalet Lapin Blanc, Meribel starts from €43,330 on a catered basis.

Outside on the terrace, a sunken hot tub and seating area with fire pit offers the perfect place from which to admire the views. Margaux's hand painted interior décor and traditional wood features lend it a timeless and charming elegance and its ornately carved wraparound balconies offer views of the surrounding peaks. The homely retreat features six ensuite bedrooms, an additional master suite complete with lobby, study and bathroom, an inviting living and dining area with large fireplace, TV room, indoor hot tub and a bar.
