This stunning town, 30 minutes north of Chambéry, is picture postcard perfect. Situated on the shores of crystal-clear Lake Annecy, it is known as the Venice of the Alps due to the Thiou River that flows through it.

The winding, narrow old town streets and bridges attract tourists year-round, populating the many cafes, bistros and patisseries. Again, cafe culture was in

full swing here, you really are spoilt for choice as to where you can sit and take it all in.

The old town's main attraction is the Palais de l'île, a 12th-century house that sits on an island in the middle of the canal. You will know when you're near due to the throng of tourists all gathered on the bridge opposite to snap a picture.

If the hustle and bustle of the busy streets is too much, simply head off on a walk along the lake or put your feet up and take a relaxing cruise.

Returning to the hotel later that evening, it was the turn of La Cantine, the chateau's exceptional restaurant, to steal the limelight.

The restaurant is always busy and its reputation pulls in diners do, as we couldn't visit the Auvergne-Rhône-Alps region and not go up a mountain. So we jumped in our motor and drove to the top of Mont Revard.

Arriving at the summit you could hear people gasping as they held up their phones to photograph the last rays of sunlight creeping over the epic peaks of the Juras lighting up
