All dishes pair perfectly with specially selected wines from Château de Candie's extensive wine list. Guests can even sample the Viognier wine made with grapes picked from the château's own vineyard, at a fascinating wine tasting workshop.

The restaurant team will be on hand throughout to ensure guests want for nothing and can enjoy the produce from the château – whether it's the Viognier wine grown on the château grounds or the honey from the château's own beehives.
