Chalet Iona, Le Villard, Les Allues, Méribel Valley

Location:

A mere 8 minute drive from the nearest Olympie telecabine at Les Allues (the heart of the world's largest ski area) and a 15–20 minute drive to the centre of Méribel, Chalet Iona could be just the ticket. Situated within its own private orchards in Vanoise National Park, guests will overlook a stretch of 13 picturesque villages sure to evoke more than just a few appreciative "oohs' and "aahs." And the surrounding Grand Bec Mountain, is, of course, nothing short of magnificent.



Accommodation:

Chalet Iona has been the recipient of a hefty makeover – in 2017 it was completely rebuilt, and this year it's been refurbished with families in mind. There are three sprawling master suites – one with adjoining children's bunks. There are two further double guest rooms, sleeping 15 in total when combined with the annexe property – Chalet India. Expect an open plan layout with large, East-facing windows and a dramatic suspended replace. It's the perfect space for large groups and multi-generational families.

Comfort is key at Chalet Iona. The concierge and a gold-standard chalet team are on hand to ensure your stay is a relaxing one, while the on-demand chauffeur service will have you slopeside in minutes. Logistics are a breeze thanks to the in-chalet ski and boot fitting service, while your lift pass will be waiting for you on arrival. A family meal at the hand-made oak dining table?
