Ski France, the go-to company for places to stay in the French Alps, has a new luxury addition: Chalet Genepy in Val d'Isère. The Location

Just a 10-minute walk from the resort centre and only a five-minute drive to the Solaise Express lifts and nearby pistes.

The Chalet

Chalet Genepy combines traditional alpine style – think wooden beams, stone fireplace, and cosy interiors – with modern luxury touches. The chalet accommodates 10 adults across five double bedrooms, plus a separate bunk room sleeping an additional four guests.

Ground floor Four bedrooms, two en suite and two sharing a shower room. A ski room with heated boot racks and a wellness area with an indoor swimming pool, steam room and chill-out space.

First floor An open plan living and dining area with fireplace, comfortable sofas, and state-of-the-art TV. It also offers a terrace with mountain views, a modern kitchen, and a second lounge.

Second floor A luxurious master suite with en suite bathroom, alongside another en suite bedroom.

World-class ski holiday

Val d'Isère is one of the most prestigious ski resorts in the world. The resort combines modern facilities with authentic alpine heritage. Beyond skiing, guests can enjoy an outdoor ice rink, an aqua-sports centre and a cinema, alongside a lively programme including international competitions, snow-sculpture exhibitions and concerts.

A seven-night stay departing November 30 costs £10,330 total based on 12 sharing a five-bedroom chalet. Flights, food and transfers extra.
